OR exit 5 North to 91 West, (move to right immediately) to exit at Beach, go left on Beach (South), and it will be on your left after Medieval Times and before Ripley's (if you go past Ripley's Believe It or Not, you have gone too far), and across from Movieland Wax museum (before La Palma).
